

Greenfield Boys Basketball Club - Select Basketball

The GBBC is a not for profit organization that provides basketball training for boys in grades 4-8 who are Greenfield residents and/or currently enrolled in a Greenfield district school. The club was formed by Carl Streeter and is staffed by parent volunteers.

The goal of the GBBC is to develop young basketball players into athletes who can compete at an advanced level when they enter high school. The club provides coaching, practice, competitive league and tournament play as well as additional training opportunities.

Teams will play both league and tournament games starting in the fall of 2017 and running until spring of 2018. Locations of league games will vary. Tournament entries will be determined by the coaching staff but will not typically include any overnight stays. Practices will held twice weekly and generally run for 90 minutes between the hours of 5:00 and 9:00 PM.

2017-18 GBBC fees are \$200 per player. In addition to the club fee, there is a \$100 volunteer fee. The volunteer fee is refundable upon the completion of your volunteer tenure. Typical volunteer duties include working our home tournament at the high school, coaching, or supporting our year end banquet. **New players as well as returning players may also be required to purchase new uniforms.**

There is no cost to tryout and you do not need to pre-register. The dates for this year's tryouts are:
